Check link on SD83 website for board meeting summary from last week: Main topics are:

1. draft calendar for 2024/2025 school year - please provide any feedback by March 12 before sent to ministry;
2. Food programs - presentation by Serena Caner was excellent and available for viewing online - funding for 3 year "feeding future funding programs" (about $\$ 900,000$ ) to support food in schools - all schools now have breakfast program and top up snack program; and 3. School configuration still in discussion and push to start making movement towards formal plan. There are two main models to decide between at present: 3 high schools (812) with SMS becoming the third HS, and then all elementary schools ( $\mathrm{K}-7$ ) or 2 HS model ( 8 12) and K-7 in all elementary school, and SMS would become an elementary school. Change to occur 2025/2026 school year but will need a transition plan for certain grades (such as grade 10 needing to choose grade 12 courses; and grade 6's who will be in middle school). Priority is not to have portables at all the elementary schools so may change SMS into an elementary school. Planning to obtain parent feedback - March $7^{\text {th }}$ in person at 4:30pm but might be later. Marianne to confirm time and option for childcare. Will be virtual option. Can also give feedback to Marianna by phone/social media/email to give feedback on her behalf. Any decision must align with strategic plan - eliminate unnecessary transitions between schools and optimize participation and attendance at schools. Feedback will allow for open ended commentary/questions and then a survey later on.

## Questions:

- Late immersion program - how would this work? There are discussions occurring about programs of choice. Nothing determined yet.
- Question about catchment - also up for discussion/TBD

5. Treasurer's report - Caitlyn
